REPORTS TO THE LEGISLATURE

ABSTRACT

The Montana Legislature receives hundreds of statutorily required reports from various state agencies, interim committees, as well as the Governor's Office. The Legislative Services Division, in accordance with 5-11-210, MCA, compiles reports to the Legislature prior to the start of each session and offers those reports to individual legislators. The law requires the division to act as a clearinghouse or repository for reports. At the Legislative Council's January meeting, members approved the development of a bill draft to address inconsistent reporting references and requirements throughout the code. The bill draft, with all updated and corrected references, is 190 pages (PD004). It is available for review on the Legislative Council's website [here](#). The information in PD004A provides the two sections of the draft with significant content changes. Staff is seeking additional input on the proposal and approval to advance the draft for review by the 2021 Legislature.

PD004 and PD004A Overview

The proposed draft legislation outlines the changes highlighted in the table provided below. The proposed changes include adding a reference to 5-11-210, MCA in all reporting statutes to allow for proper tracking of reports and a list of reports included in [section 1] to clarify reports to the legislature, reports to interim committees, and reports to the fiscal analyst and finance committee. The draft does not eliminate any existing reporting requirements but, as highlighted below, does propose some changes and clarifications to the entities that formally receive legislative reports and to the frequency of some reports. It also eliminates reports that have expired. For example, a single report due in 2019 is removed from the list.
