Beginning with the pay period ending April 5, 2024, the cost of salary and benefits for Mr. Triem's employment will be paid 50% from the funds appropriated to the legislative branch in Section 14 of HB 856, and 50% will be paid from the funds appropriated to the LFD in HB 2. This shared arrangement of time and cost is anticipated to end with the FY 2025 but may be extended by mutual agreement

of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Finance Committee Management

Advisory Work Group.
