

2021 Feed Bill (67th Legislature)
Explanation of Appropriation Balances

Updated: 5/13/2023

SENATE – REMAINING BALANCE - \$311,290

- Largely due to the State Health Insurance Premium Holiday (2 Months)
- The Senate had less PERS buybacks than what was budgeted

HOUSE – REMAINING BALANCE - \$180,970

- State Health Insurance Premium Holiday (2 Months)

LEGISLATIVE SERVICES DIVISION – REMAINING BALANCE - \$537,363

- Legislator Constituent Services Account
 - 21 legislators did not claim all or part of the \$3,000 primary amount.
 - The secondary amount is based on the square mileage of a legislator's district (90 eligible districts).
 - 45 legislators claimed \$0
 - 29 legislators claimed less than the full amount
 - 16 legislators claimed the full allowable amount
- Operating Expenses
 - Covid related savings
 - Remote Device Connectivity (paid through LSD's ITSD budget)
 - TEAMS Licenses (paid through LSD's ITSD budget)
 - Remote Session Support
 - Contact Tracers/Nurse
 - Other Savings
 - Mazurek Building – Additional Storage Space Rent
