








Making appropriations for Legislative Branch for the fiscal year end



Iowa's Uniform Electronic Legal Materials Act (UELMA) enacted in 2019 Iowa Acts, ch. 92, was implemented on January 9, 2020. Under the Act, a member of the public accessing a document on the General Assembly's website may authenticate the document. A document subject to authentication at least includes legal material which is an edition, or part of an edition, of an official legal publication made available to the public on General Assembly's website on and after the Act's implementation date. By authenticating a document, a member of the public determines that the legal material is unaltered from the legal material stored as custodial information in a secure electronic repository controlled and maintained by the Legislative Services Agency and used to produce print and electronic versions of the edition as provided in Iowa Code chapter 2B.






Below are the steps to authenticate a document:

- · Click 'Authenticate' to validate if document is an official document.


