- Based off initial planning work the audit scope will involve eGov workgroups, all agencies involved in the eGov system will be surveyed/interviewed.
- General timeframe of review will be last three years of eGov workgroup activity, transition period over the course of 2021, and governance structure moving forward.
- Security and compliance standards will be reviewed, and security documentation will be sampled to ensure compliance is met.
- We will identify the management structure of the transaction fund and how it is applied to eGov services.
