RE: Annual Report on Medical Marijuana Complaints

In compliance with 37-3-203(3) MCA, the Board of Medical Examiners (Board) is providing this annual report on the number of complaints and disciplinary actions involving physician practices in providing written certification of individuals for use of marijuana for a debilitating medical condition provided for in Title 50, chapter 46.

From July 1, 2019 through May 31, 2020, the Board received two complaints against one licensee regarding the written certification of individuals for use of medical marijuana.

Both complaints are currently under investigation.

During the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019, no physicians were disciplined by the board for their practices in providing written certification for the use of marijuana for a debilitating medical condition.
