A sturdy Internet connection and a microphone are required to provide comment via your computer.

After providing that information, you'll receive instructions no later than **10 a.m. on August 12** for joining and participating in the meeting.

During the public comment periods, people who have joined the meeting may electronically "raise their hand" and participate after being recognized by the presiding officer or the Zoom manager. Comments will be taken in the order received.
