Dear Committee Members,

As a public member and a dentist, I would like to comment on "Board of Dentistry Proposed New Rule II", before this committee on Nov. 7 at 10 am.

I have attached a copy of "Statement of Facts" to a lawsuit that I am being forced to file, against the Department of Labor & Industries, Board of Dentistry, members and staff. Very similar to the FTC vs North Carolina Dental Board. (This statement is a working draft, and content could change from the copy actually filed). These facts are undisputable and tell how the Montana Dental Assn, though the Dental Board as ordered from the American Dental Assn., conspired, concealed, lied, stole and has restrained the profession of Dentistry, which the people of Montana authorized in 1984 by the initiative process. Only to be stolen by a bill introduced and sponsored by the American Dental Assn.. Legislative records and by the discovery process, will prove these allegations true, and produce more defendants. Since the facts are self explanatory, I say no more about them.

I would like to call to your attention one more fact of great importance. At the same time Dentistry is trying to pass this unjustified rule on the dentist, they have also proposed a rule where the dentist have to be examined on removable prosthetics. What !!! you mean dentist are being allowed to provide denture related services without being tested...? A look at dental education, National Board exams and studies by dental educators, will show the dentist do not have the education to provide denture services including implants. And they are not TESTED...?

This Committee, can and has the power to remedy this very large problem.

1. Immediately remove the profession of Dentistry from the anti-competitive Board of Dentistry. MCA provide for a profession without a board to exist. This will allow the professions members to organize and present a plan to the next legislature to either return to the original initiative language, or

to update.

2. Open up negotiations with myself and anyone else that will/could join in a very embarrassing and far reaching lawsuit concerning these matters.

I pray this committee will represent what is the best for the citizens of this state, correcting this problem by using the 2 options presented to it.
