


Montana Agriculture Adaptability Program

Over 100 small and medium-sized food and agriculture businesses were awarded over \$1 million, with a maximum award of \$10,000, in direct grants through the Montana Agriculture Adaptability Program (MTAAP). These grants offer immediate relief to businesses adapting to COVID-19, increasing community resilience to pandemics and other economic disruptions, while also bolstering food security. The program application closed June 12, 2020.
