

Free statewide math remediation provided by funding from the Dennis and Phyllis Washington Foundation

 After successful startup MDPLN transitioned to OPI and renamed the Teacher Learning Hub

 **Credit Recovery Reboot**

Utilizing Shape grant funding MTDA developed a homegrown system to administer credit recovery


 **Additional Electives Added**




Advanced Placement Overall Enrollments




