However, the board may hire its own personnel, and 2-15-121(2)(d) doesn't not apply. 17 (3) The board is composed of 18 members appointed by the governor in accordance with 2-15-124 and any special requirements of Title I of the Omnibus Crime Control and Safe Streets Act, as amended. The 18 19 board must be representative of state and local law enforcement and criminal justice agencies, including agencies directly related to the prevention and control of juvenile delinquency, units of general local 20 21 government, and public agencies maintaining programs to reduce and control crime and must include 22 representatives of citizens and professional and community organizations, including organizations directly 23 related to delinquency prevention."" 24 NEW SECTION. Section 2. {standard} Repealer. The following sections of the Montana Code 25 26 Annotated are repealed: 27 2-15-2307. Crime control bureau.

Commented [WR1]: Section 2-15-121(2)(d) requires the department to which an agency is allocated for administrative purposes only to provide the staff for the allocated agency. The language in HJ31-1 allows the Board of Crime Control to hire its own staff.
