# WASTEWATER SYSTEM FUNDING OPTIONS

Multiple funding options at both the federal and state levels exist to help local governments fund wastewater projects. However, private homeowners have few funding programs available. Limited funding is offered for septic replacement, but funding to install a new system is restricted to low-income homeowners with no options to hook up to a sewer system.

The funding options are organized by system and program type.
