2	Ethics – apply to Boards and Commissions	MSC found in Sheehy v COPP Boards and commissions subject to the Constitution's Code of Ethics, but the statute as written does not confer jurisdiction for enforcement at either the state or local level. 3	Clarify City candidate filing dates	2019 Legislature updated time and dates for filing campaign finance reports with COPP specifically for the June primary and November general election. City primary is generally in September.
