SUMMARY OF RULE(S):

On September 6, 2019, the Secretary of State proposed to amend two rules and repeal nine rules modifying the fees for services provided for records housed in the state records center and imaging services. However, as published in the September 20, 2019, Montana Administrative Register, the Secretary of State has decided to withdraw the proposed changes to give the office additional time to consider the proposed rules. Any proposed changes will be re-noticed in the future.

NOTES: A previously scheduled public hearing will not be held. The public comment period ends on October 4, 2019.
