



1 (b) "Educational disruption" means a disruption experienced during grades nine through twelve caused  
2 by homelessness, involvement in the child welfare system or juvenile justice system, a medical or mental health  
3 crisis, or other event deemed a qualifying educational disruption by the trustees of the district,

4 (b) "Homelessness" has the same meaning as provided in 42 U.S.C. 11434a(2);

5 (c) "Pupil" has the same meaning as provided in 20-1-101.

7 **NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction.** [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an  
8 integral part of Title 20, chapter 7, part 13, and the provisions of Title 20, chapter 7, part 13, apply to [section 1].
