



The Montana Aeronautics Board is a quasi-judicial board consisting of nine members, each appointed by the Governor and confirmed by the Senate for a four-year term.

The Board acts in an advisory capacity to the department and has statutory authority over allocation of airport development loan and grant funds and pavement preservation grant funds. The members represent various facets of the industry and at least one member of the board is an attorney licensed to practice law in this state.

- One member of the Montana Pilots' Association;
- One member of the Montana Chamber of Commerce;
- One representative of the Montana Airport Management Association (MAMA);
- One member of the Montana Association of Counties or the Montana League of Cities and Towns;
- One person actively engaged in aviation education in this state;
- One person representative of interstate commercial airline operators;
- One person representing the general public;
- One member of the Association of Montana Aerial Applicators; and
- One person who is an active fixed base operator in this state, or an official of a fixed base operator in this state, of flying services or flying schools.
