Review of working group actions

- 10:05:35 Jason Mohr, research analyst, Legislative Services Division, said this is the fifth meeting of the geocodes working group and provided instructions for the meeting. He said Bryce Kaatz is representing the Department of Revenue.
- 10:06:32 Mr. Mohr said for the meeting today the working group will consider advancing to the WPIC its recommendations for the water right ownership update process (Exhibit 1) and two bill drafts. (Exhibit 2) He said the working group received an email response from the Department of Natural Resources and Conservation (DNRC) regarding the proposals.

10:07:35 Rep. Z. Brown said he talked to Laura Rennick, deputy administrator, and Jan Langel, Water Resources Division administrator, DNRC, regarding the department's perspective on the proposals.

Administrative recommendations to WPIC

10:08:48	Mr. Mohr discussed the seven administrative recommendations and said they do not need to be put into statute. (see exhibit 1)
10:12:15	Rep. Z. Brown said he spoke with Mr. Langel and he indicated that the DNRC would prefer to ask for an audit before making any legislative changes. He said today the working group needs to come to a consensus on the recommendations and make a formal motion to advance the recommendations to the WPIC at its meeting next week.
10:13:32	Krista Lee Evans, Association of Gallatin Agricultural Irrigators and Senior Water Rights Coalition, commented on the DNRC recommendations.
10:15:00	Ms. Evans discussed the recommendation from the Water Court.
10:16:00	Ms. Evans said she recommends that the DNRC incorporate the suggestions into its 1993 policy handbook on ownership updates and not the existing policy handbook.
10:16:33	Rep. Z. Brown asked Mr. Mohr if he needed clarification on the suggestions.
10:17:02	Rep. Z. Brown asked Ms. Evans to make a formal motion after the working group discussion.
10:17:28	Rep. Sales asked Mr. Mohr about the time frame for the audit.
10:19:17	Rep. Z. Brown said Mr. Langel felt that some of the legislative changes were premature and that a full audit would allow time to get objective information and take a broader look at the issue. He said he did not feel that the working group needed to stop its work and wait for an audit.
10:20:11	Ms. Rennick said she is available to answer any questions regarding the response from the department. She said the agency is supportive of the seven recommendations and agrees with the suggested changes from Ms. Evans.
