

PROPOSED CFHHS LEGISLATION SUMMARY FOR ASSIGNMENT OF SPONSORS

BACKGROUND

The table below lists legislation already approved or still under consideration for introduction in the 2023 Legislature. At its August meeting, the Children and Families Committee must assign sponsors to carry the bills it has approved, keeping in mind that:

- bills containing an appropriation, marked with an asterisk below, must be introduced in the House; and
- the committee must choose a backup sponsor for any bill assigned to a committee member who has an opponent in the November election. A backup sponsor must be chosen from among the following holdover senators or unopposed candidates: Senators Friedel, Gross, and Manzella and Senator-Elect Lenz.
