




**All Healthy MT Kids Plus (HMK+) Medicaid Expansion expenditures are matched with CHIP funding and the CHIP match rate. All HMK+ Medicaid expansion (CHIP funded) expenditures are paid through the Health Resources Division (HRD) and are not budgeted through the Children's Mental Health Bureau. The expenditures are shown in this section because they are mental health services managed within the Children's Mental Health Bureau. This provides the most complete picture of children's mental health services provided by DPHHS.


Prior to January 1, 2020 Comprehensive School & Community Treatment (CSCT) had a School match. The CSCT amounts shown does not inlcude any School match

As illustrated in the chart, most clients that receive Comprehensive School & Community Treatment (CSCT) will also receive a mental health service outside of the CSCT program. Many clients will have eligibility in both HMK Medicaid and HMK+ Expansion during a year and that is why the unduplicated figure of 21,933 served is not equal to the sum of both programs listed in the table.
