

Questions for Criminal Justice System Stakeholders About Data Bills (HJ 31 Study)

The Law and Justice Interim Committee (LJIC) is seeking feedback on several draft bills it is considering as part of the [HJ 31 study](#). The LJIC provided initial directions to stakeholders [in a March 2022 letter](#). In addition, the LJIC wants the agencies to address several specific questions for the LJIC's May 9-10 meeting. The questions were posed during a [March work session](#). The numbers in parentheses indicate the time the question was asked in the work session.

- Is the agency involved with any Snowflake data sharing projects with the State Data Officer and ITSD? If so what type of project(s) and where in the process is the project? (12:15:10 – Lynch)
- What is the status of the agency with a unique identifier project to share information about individuals with other agencies? (12:15:45 – Lynch)
- HJ 31-1 contains data collection requirements broken out into sections for most parts of the criminal justice process. In the sections that contain requirements related to your agency's work, what data do you already collect? (12:23:00 – Lynch)
- What technical resources, staffing, and/or analysis do you need to implement next steps or identify what next steps are needed for better integration and analysis? (12:27 – Bishop)
