Charter

A Purpose

The purpose of the Montana Integrated Justice Information Sharing (MIJIS) Executive Advisory Group (EAG) is to advise the Montana Attorney General (AG) on ways to improve the information sharing of public safety information by coordinating state, local, and tribal justice-related technology initiatives using standardized and cost-effective methods.

Montana Justice Community of Interest (JCOI) stakeholders recognize that the public safety is a collection of separate and independent agencies that each manage and plan for technology resources according to their needs and priorities. JCOI stakeholders further acknowledge that they rely on each other for information in order to fulfill their individual business operations, yet access to and exchange of complete, timely, and accurate data is complicated by the fact that information systems are somewhat isolated and may not effectively communicate with one another.

B Scope

The MIJIS EAG will advise the AG in the following areas:

- Governance, policy, procedures, collective priorities, conflicts, development, implementation, and enhancement of MIJIS initiatives.
- Shared infrastructure and maximization of previous and on-going information technology investments by state, local, and tribal public JCOI agencies.
- Enterprise strategic plan that defines the vision, mission, goals, and objectives that enhance statewide JCOI information sharing. The EAG will review and update the strategic plan every biennium.
- Resources and funding for MIJIS initiatives, projects and activities.
- Data, architecture, and technology standards.
- Project management.
- Sub-working/focus groups as necessary to provide recommendations on detailed topics or issues related to MIJIS technology or business processes.
