RE: Annual Report on Medical Marijuana Complaints

In compliance with 37-3-203(3) MCA, the Board of Medical Examiners is providing this annual report on the number of complaints and disciplinary actions involving physician practices in providing written certification of individuals for use of marijuana for a debilitating medical condition provided for in Title 50, chapter 46.

From July 1, 2020 through May 31, 2021, the Board received no complaints about its licensees regarding the written certification of individuals for use of medical marijuana.

During the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020, no investigations into physician practices in providing written certification were opened. There are two cases from 2019 that are still under investigation.

During the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2020, no physicians were disciplined by the board for their practices in providing written certification for the use of marijuana for a debilitating medical condition.
