MONTANA COAL ENDOWMENT PROGRAM PROGRAM OVERVIEW

HISTORY

- The Montana Coal Endowment Program (MCEP) was formerly called the Treasure State Endowment Program
- It was authorized in 1992 through a legislative referendum
- The program is administered by the Montana Department of Commerce

PURPOSE

• To help fund infrastructure projects and planning

FUNDING

- The program is funded biennially through legislative action
- The source of funds is Coal Severance Tax interest earnings or bonds
- 2021 Biennium Awards = \$31.2 million
- 2023 Biennium Awards = \$27.7 million

THREE TYPES OF GRANTS

Construction Grants – See details below and attached timeline

Planning Grants – Accepted on a rolling basis until funds expended

Emergency grants - Accepted on a rolling basis until funds expended

CONSTRUCTION GRANT DETAILS

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS


- Incorporated cities and towns
- Counties
- Tribal governments
- · County or multi-county water, sewer, or solid waste districts
- An authority as defined in 75-6-304, MCA (e.g., regional water authority)

ELIGIBLE PROJECTS

- Drinking water systems
- Wastewater treatment facilities
- Sanitary or storm sewer systems
- Solid waste disposal & separation systems
- Bridges

Maximum grant amount available is \$750,000, \$625,000 or \$500,000 dependent on user rates being charged in the project area. Bridge projects are generally limited to \$500,000.
