

Vision: Build statewide drought resilience

Funding

- \$100K from 2019 legislature
- \$200K from Bureau of Reclamation
- \$400K total budget (includes in-kind DNRC staff time)







How do we plan and manage for drought?

1) Understand risks and impacts. Assess vulnerabilities to drought by reviewing data (climate, demographic, social) and using information from stakeholders.

2) Find ways to lessen impacts before next drought occurs. Local and state-level solutions to minimizing impacts.

3) Track water availability and climate conditions to assess and characterize drought.

Formalize and document process and assess metrics

4) Coordinate resources and communications to mitigate immediate impacts of drought.


