MAR Notice Number: 17-427

Notice Description: Notice of Public Hearing on Proposed Adoption

Subject: Temporary water quality standards variances

**Summary:** 17-427 is a proposal to adopt one new rule regarding temporary water quality standards variances. This implements 75-5-320, MCA, which was enacted after the 2019 legislative session. The new rule would provide the criteria and procedures for the department to issue temporary variances. A variance could be granted for one of six factors. To issue a variance, the department would seek approval from the Environmental Protection Agency and hold a public hearing. The department would review an issued variance every 5 years.

**Notes/Hearing:** A hearing is scheduled for 10 a.m. on August 18, 2022, in Room 111 of the Metcalf Building, 1520 East Sixth Avenue, Helena, MT. The hearing will also be conducted over Zoom.

Notice Description: Notice of Public Hearing on Proposed Amendment and Repeal

Subject: Dam Safety

**Summary:** 36-22-216 is a proposal to amend 10 existing rules and repeal 1 existing rule regarding dam safety.

**Notes/Hearing:** The department scheduled a hearing for August 9, 2022, and the public comment period closed on the same date.
