This deletion aligns the ARM with a 2017 court order finding the reporting requirements invalid and brings the rule into alignment with current department practice.

Brief description: Adopts and incorporates changes to the Children's Mental Health Bureau Medicaid Services Provider Manual. These changes make Mental Health Intensive Outpatient Therapy a permanent benefit, allow for the use of telehealth for certain youth mental health services, remove certain prior authorization requirements, amend continued stay review requirements for therapeutic group homes, clarify that an out-of-state therapeutic group home must be licensed in the state in which it operates, and remove an outdated minimum pay requirement for direct care workers.

These regulations ensure, among other things, that individuals receiving HCBS have access to the greater community, including opportunities to seek employment and work in competitive settings, engage in community life, control personal resources, and receive services in the community, to the same degree of access as individuals not receiving HCBS.
