





 - 2022 Survey collected between Apr 11, 2022 and Sep 30, 2022




Employment Status of Actively Licensed RNs in Montana






Age Distribution of Actively Licensed RNs in Montana and U.S.












Employment Status of Actively Licensed LPNs in Montana






LPN Primary Employment Setting



















