<u>Brief description:</u> Updates foster care licensing rules to ensure they are current to national standards; clearly defined; and eliminate or mitigate barriers for the department and providers, while maintaining adequate safety standards for children in care.

These changes (1) add self-direct service option to Behavioral Intervention Assistant and Life Coach; (2) add conflict-free case management criteria to the base waiver; and (3) update the Severe and Disabling Mental Illness (SDMI) waiver's case management team requirements.

ARM 37.49.601 states that applications should be filed with the Office of Public Assistance (OPA), but these applications have been handled in the Child the Family Services Division (CFSD) since 2004. ARM 37.49.602 states that redeterminations are conducted every six months, but this is no longer required.
