 - o Allow us to know who we are targeting and what might be helpful
 - Typical offender that is in the DOC system. Average/Modal (demographic information about these offenders)
- 3. How effective is sentencing?
 - a. Courts systems don't talk.

 - a. No communication of when someone is arrested in Flathead and also a user in Yellowstone County. (1,000 contacts and not even arrests) Need CAD data
- 11. Mental Health Services Who has it and who doesn't. What counties are more successful and why.
 - a. Do they have services in place that another county does not.
- 12. Mental Health Interventions when they are incarcerated.
- 13. General awareness of services available in counties.
- 14. Investment in the Criminal Justice System. The cost of the programing that is successful and investing there vs the programs that are not working in another county.
 - a. General comment based on other questions for specific programing.
- 15. Have we seen a trend in increase in car theft?
- 16. What is the difference between a one time offender and a repeat offender? (Factors)
