

# VIOLENT OFFENSES THAT REQUIRE REGISTRATION

[Section 46-23-502, MCA](#) provides the statutory definition of “Violent Offense” within the Registration of Sexual and Violent Offenders. Under the definition, there are 13 offenses that require a convicted individual to register as a violent offender in Montana. The definitions include any violation of the listed statute, as well as an attempt, solicitation, or conspiracy to commit a violation of the listed statute. Offenses that require registration include offenses for which a person was found in youth court to have committed or for which the person was adjudicated in youth court. Registration is also required for an individual who violated a reasonably similar law of another state, a tribal government, the federal government, or the military or a foreign entity.
