

VIOLENT OFFENSES THAT REQUIRE REGISTRATION

<u>Section 46-23-502, MCA</u> provides the statutory definition of "Violent Offense" within the Registration of Sexual and Violent Offenders. Under the definition, there are 13 offenses that require a convicted individual to register as a violent offender in Montana. The definitions include any violation of the listed statute, as well as an attempt, solicitation, or conspiracy to commit a violation of the listed statute. Offenses that require registration include offenses for which a person was found in youth court to have committed or for which the person was adjudicated in youth court. Registration is also required for an individual who violated a reasonably similar law of another state, a tribal government, the federal government, or the military or a foreign entity.

- Aggravated Assault (<u>45-5-202, MCA</u>)

- Assault on a Peace Officer or Judicial Officer (<u>45-5-210, MCA</u>)
- Assault on a Minor (<u>45-5-212, MCA</u>)
- Assault with a Weapon (<u>45-5-213, MCA</u>)
- Strangulation of a Partner or Family Member (<u>45-5-215, MCA</u>)
- **Kidnapping**, if the victim is not a minor (<u>45-5-302, MCA</u>)
- Aggravated Kidnapping, if the victim is not a minor (<u>45-5-303, MCA</u>)
- Robbery (<u>45-5-401, MCA</u>)
- Arson (<u>45-6-103, MCA</u>)
- Operation of Unlawful Clandestine Laboratory (<u>45-9-132, MCA</u>)
