Mental Health Treatment Opportunities, Staffing at Pine Hills Correctional Facility

Pine Hills Correctional Facility offers a wide range of mental health programming opportunities for adults and juveniles in DOC custody. Services are delivered by a team including one psychologist (sex offender treatment), three therapists, and two addiction counselors.

Offerings for juveniles based on their risk and needs assessment include:

- Individual therapy and interactive journals
- Inpatient sex offender treatment
- Chemical dependency group
- Anger management
- Phoenix New Freedom 100 Gang intervention curriculum
- Living in Balance for return probation violators
- Core Correctional Practices
- Criminal and Addictive Thinking (as needed)
- Choices and Changes (as needed)

All juveniles complete a criminal conduct cycle or Healthy Lifestyle Plan.

Offerings for adults participating in 120-day programs:

- Living in Balance
- Seeking Safety
- Relapse Prevention
- Anger Management
- Core Correctional Practices
- Motivational Mapping
