


# **SERVICES WE PROVIDE**

All states are NCOIL members. A majority of states opt to become dues-paying contributing states which entitles legislators from those states to receive travel stipends and hold NCOIL leadership positions. Travel stipends cover the meeting registration fee and reasonable travel and meal expenses.

### Insurance Legislators Foundation ("ILF")

The ILF, an independent 501(c)(3) organization separate from NCOIL but committed to its growth, is a source of scholarship opportunities for qualified legislators to attend NCOIL meetings and to participate in NCOIL discussions and debates on critical policy issues. Scholarships cover the meeting registration fee and provide for \$1,500 reasonable travel and meal expenses.
