Perimeter Fence Upgrades - Spring 2025

Low Side Housing - Spring 2025 - Fall 2027

Checkpoint Enhancements - Spring 2025 - Fall 2025

Programs Building (High side) - Summer 2025 - Spring 2027

Wallace Building Upgrades - Spring 2027 - Fall 2028

Unit D Remodel - Fall 2027 - Fall 2028



BUILDING THE FUTURE OF CORRECTIONS

COMPASS- OFFENDER MANAGEMENT SYSTEM

2023 Montana Legislature dedicated \$17.7 million in House Bill 5 to procure and implement new OMS.

- Complete Request For Proposals (RFP) and Contractor Engagement Proposal (CEP)
- Submit Information Technology Procurement Request (ITPR)
- Issue RFP (State Procurement)
- Select vendor - January 2024
- Implementation - three years

COMPASS KICKOFF TOUR

The DOC Compass project team, Berry Dunn (consultant), Mi-Case (vendor) visited Central Office, Montana State Prison, and Montana Women's Prison in August to celebrate the official start of the project and answer questions from DOC staff.



BUILDING THE FUTURE OF CORRECTIONS

AGENCY BILL DRAFT

Amend MCA 27-31-201

Amendment will allow the DOC to contact crime victims to obtain information relevant to any response to the petition when the person changing their name is under the supervision of the DOC or incarcerated in a state prison.



DOC RETURNED CITIZEN GROUP

SHARING HOPE INSIDE THE WALLS

- Established in July 2023.
- Comprised of 20 individuals who experienced periods of incarceration, community supervision, and are living successful lives today
- Group activities include:
 - o Providing input to DOC work groups
 - o Sharing Hope Inside the Walls
 - o Offering perspective at staff trainings (P&P Basic training, new employee orientation, etc.)
