10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12	Section 1. Section 45-7-207, MCA, is amended to read:
13	"45-7-207. Tampering with or fabricating physical evidence. (1) A person commits the offense of
14	tampering with or fabricating physical evidence if, believing that an official proceeding or investigation is
15	pending or about to be instituted, the person:
16	(a) alters, destroys, conceals, or removes any record, document, or thing with purpose to impair its
17	verity or availability in the proceeding or investigation; or
18	(b) makes, presents, or uses any record, document, or thing knowing it to be false and with
19	purpose to mislead any person who is or may be engaged in the proceeding or investigation.
20	(2) A person convicted of tampering with or fabricating physical evidence shall be imprisoned in
21	the state prison for a term not to exceed 10 years or be fined an amount not to exceed \$50,000, or both.
22	(3) A person convicted of tampering with or fabricating evidence in connection with a homicide or
23	homicide investigation and in so doing affects the ability of a medical examiner to determine a cause of death,
24	shall be imprisoned in the state prison for a term not to exceed 40 years or be fined an amount not to exceed
25	\$100,000, or both."
