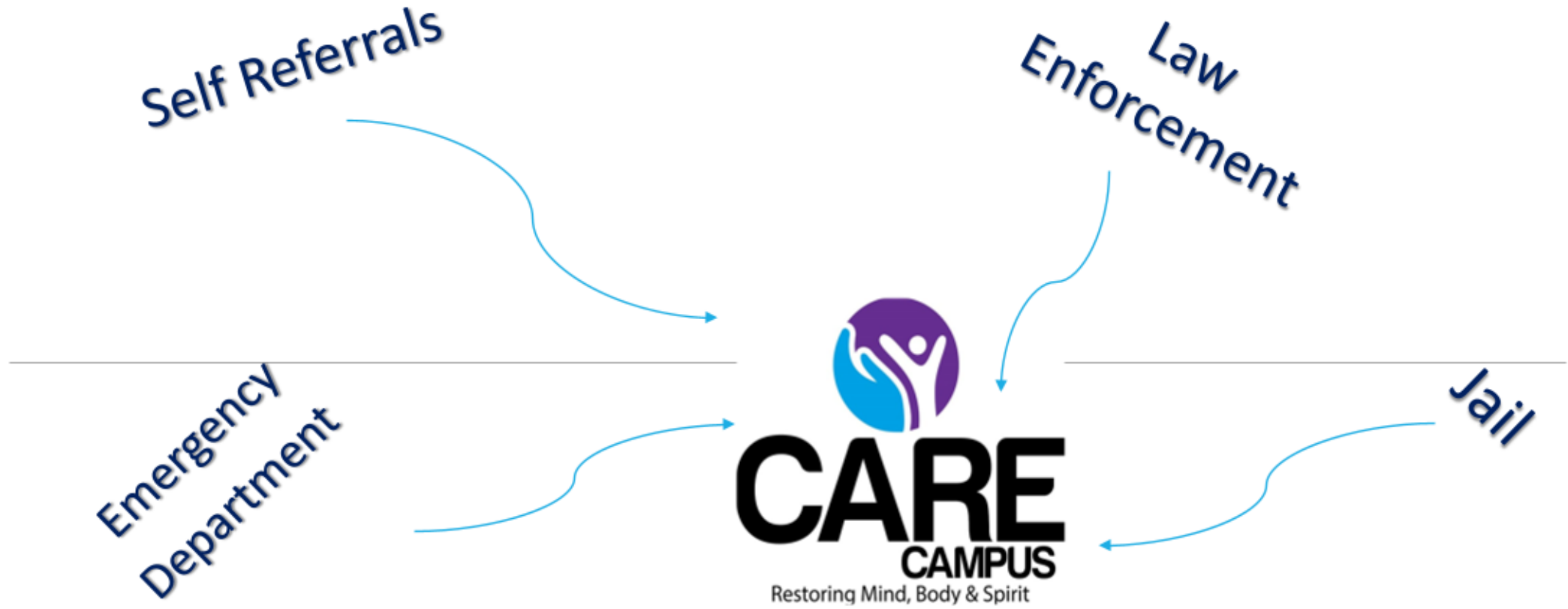

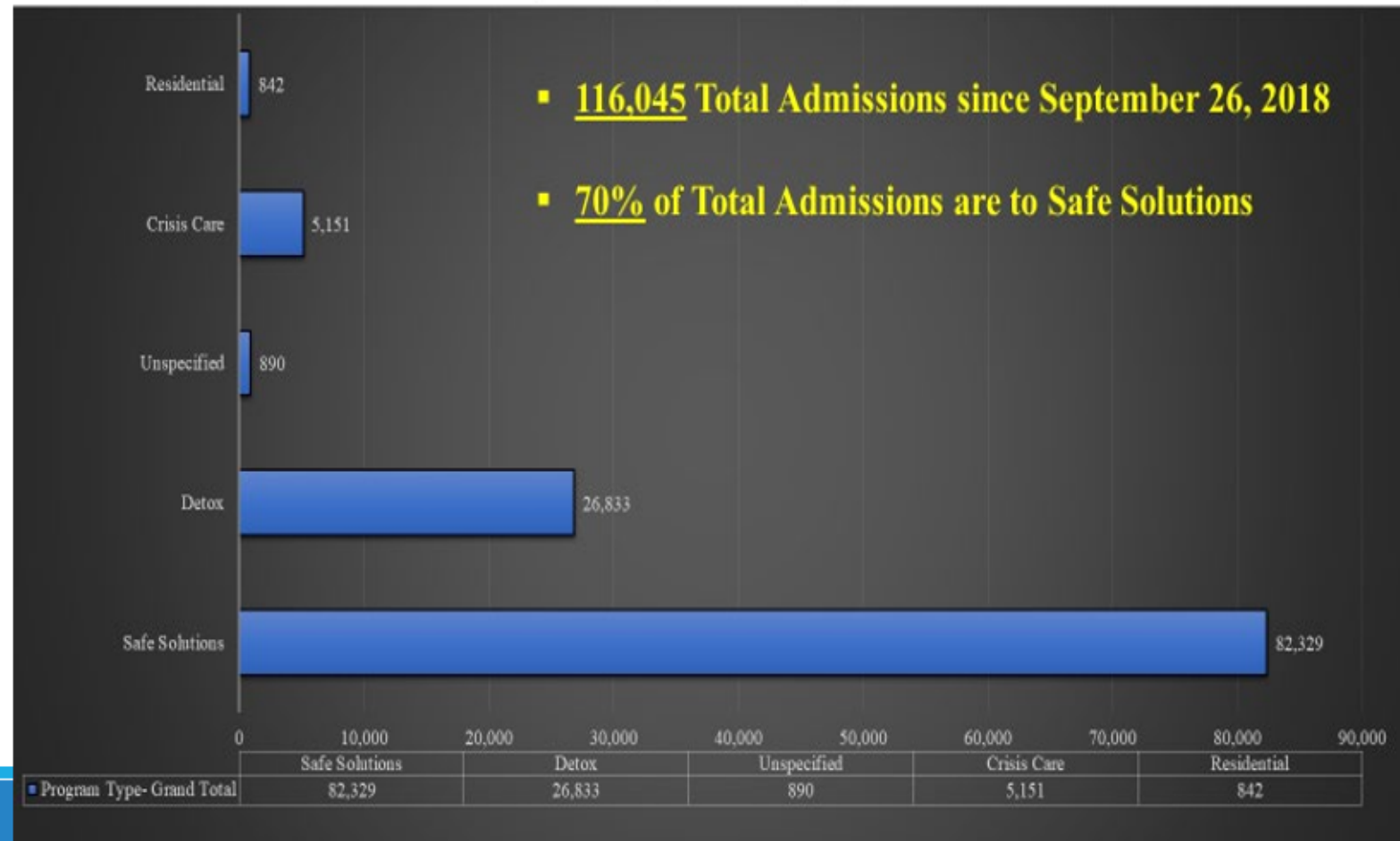
TOTAL ADMISSIONS TO CARE CAMPUS PROGRAMS

(Harm Reduction Model)

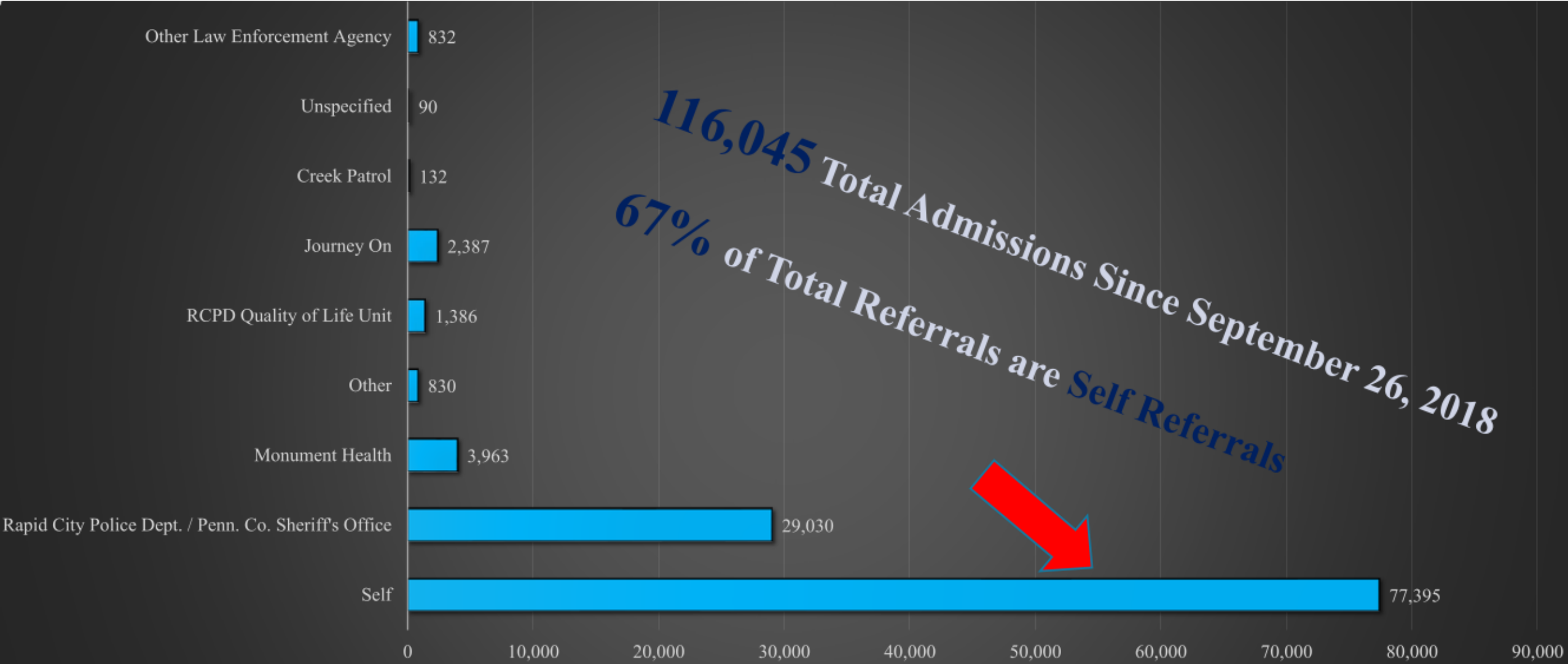


TOTAL ADMISSIONS TO CARE CAMPUS PROGRAMS (Program Type)
September 26, 2018 to May 31, 2023



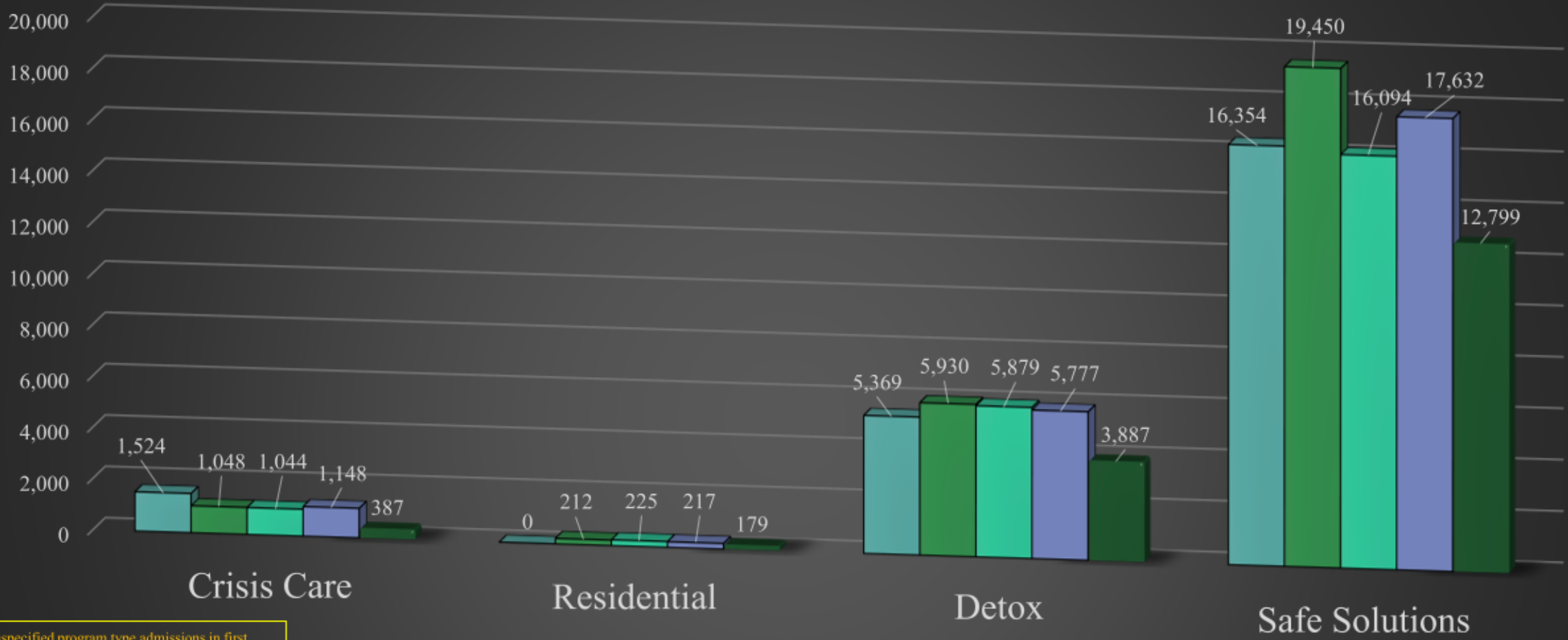

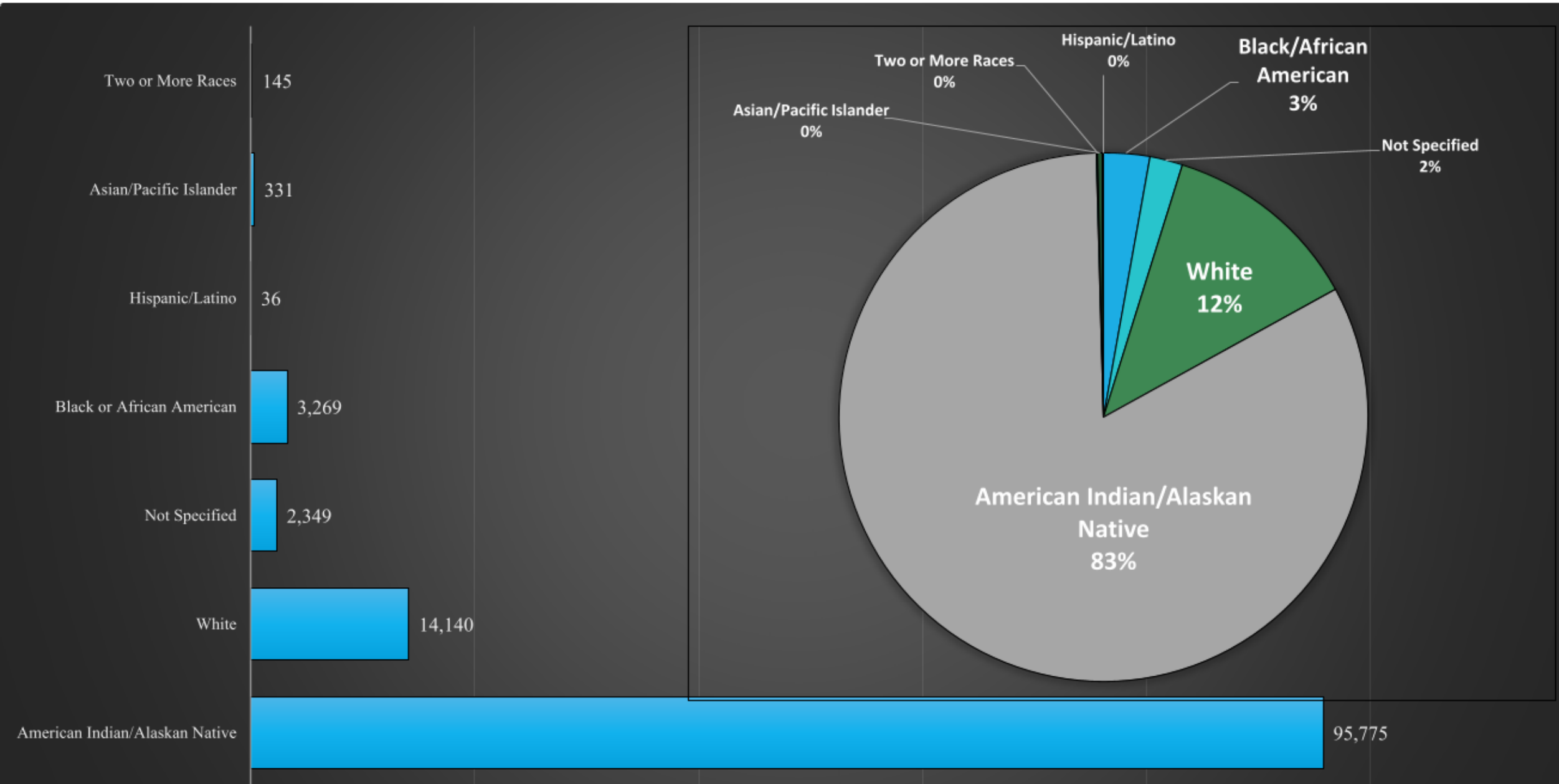

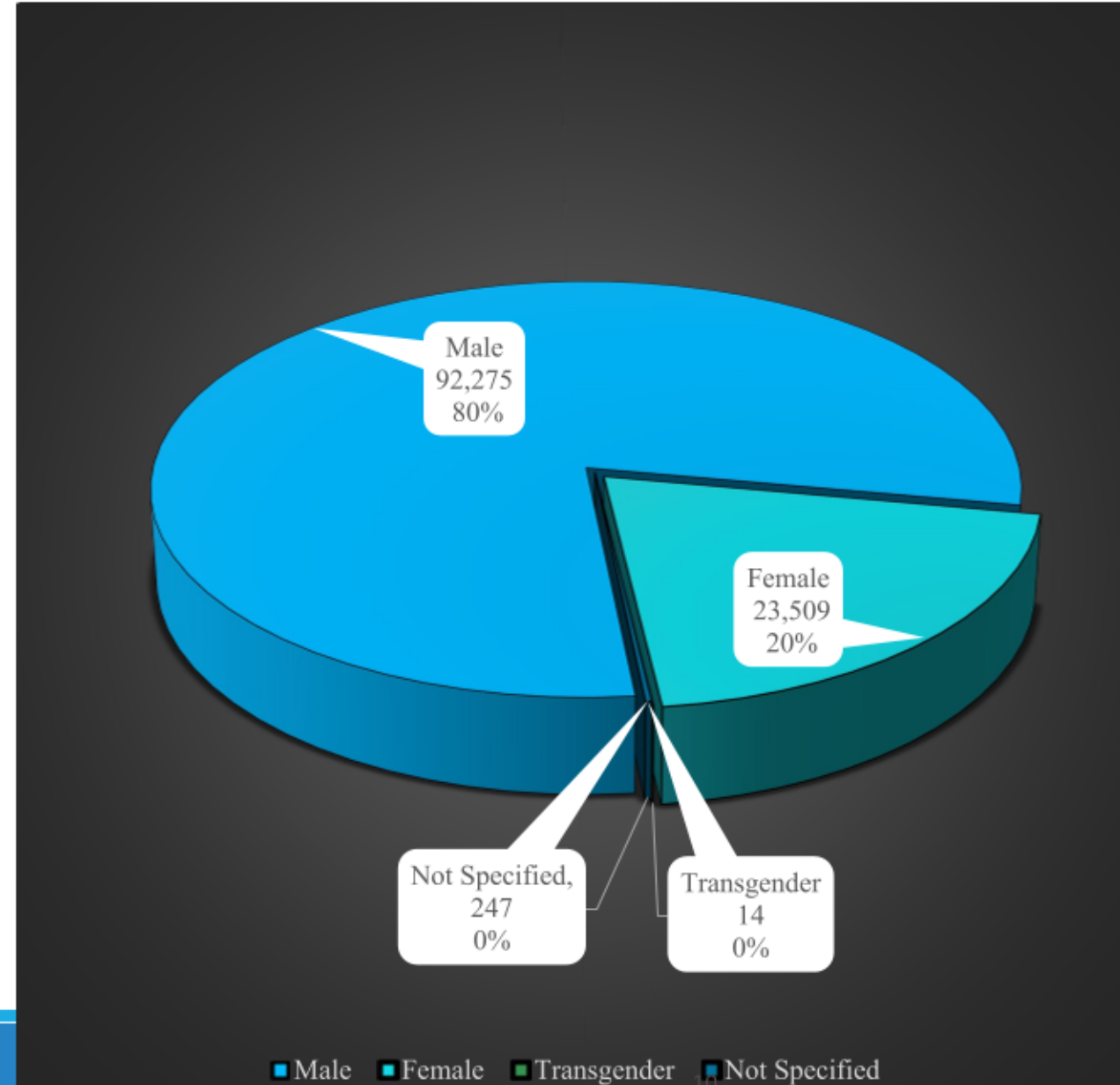
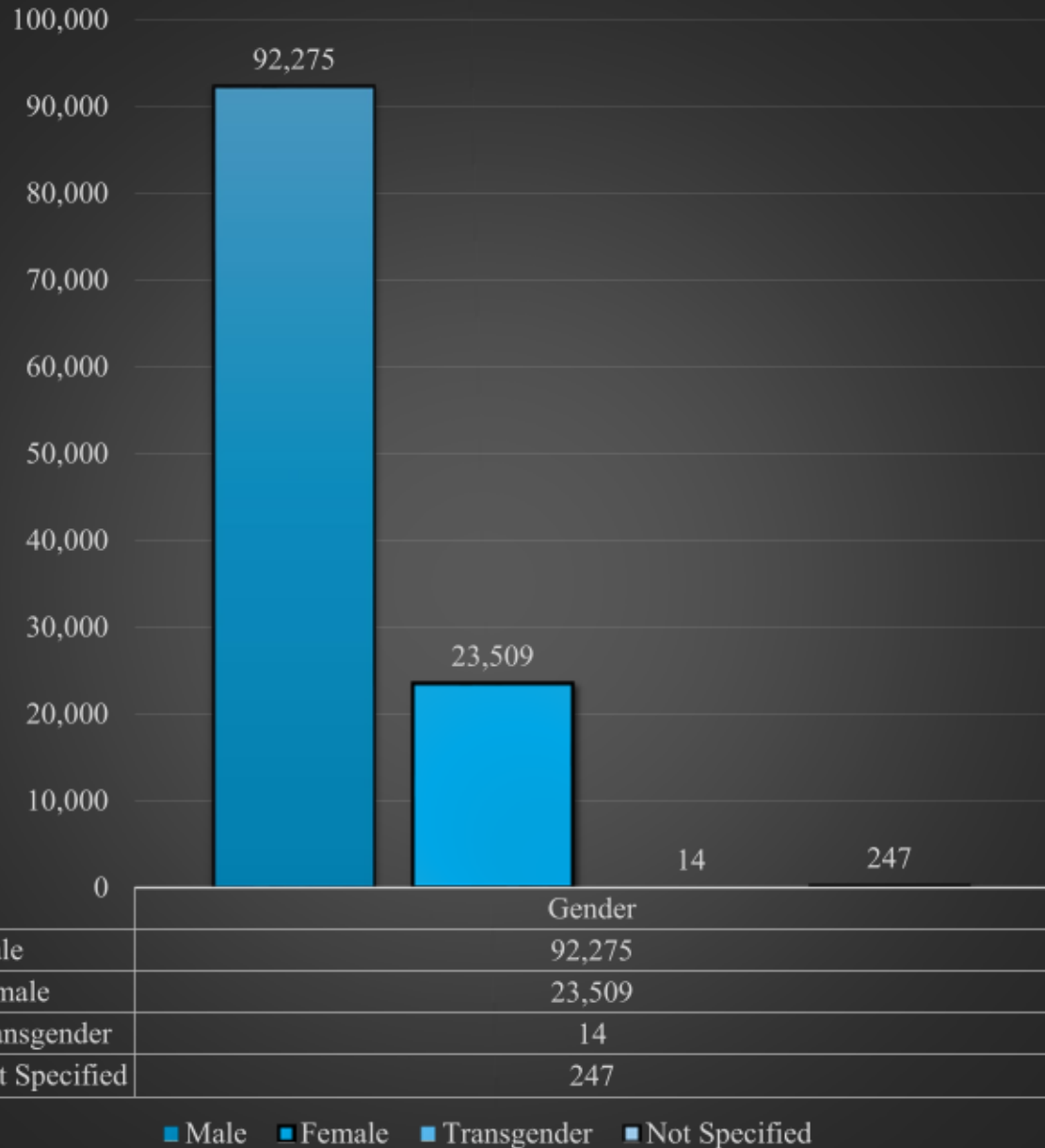
Care Campus Admissions By Race/Origin

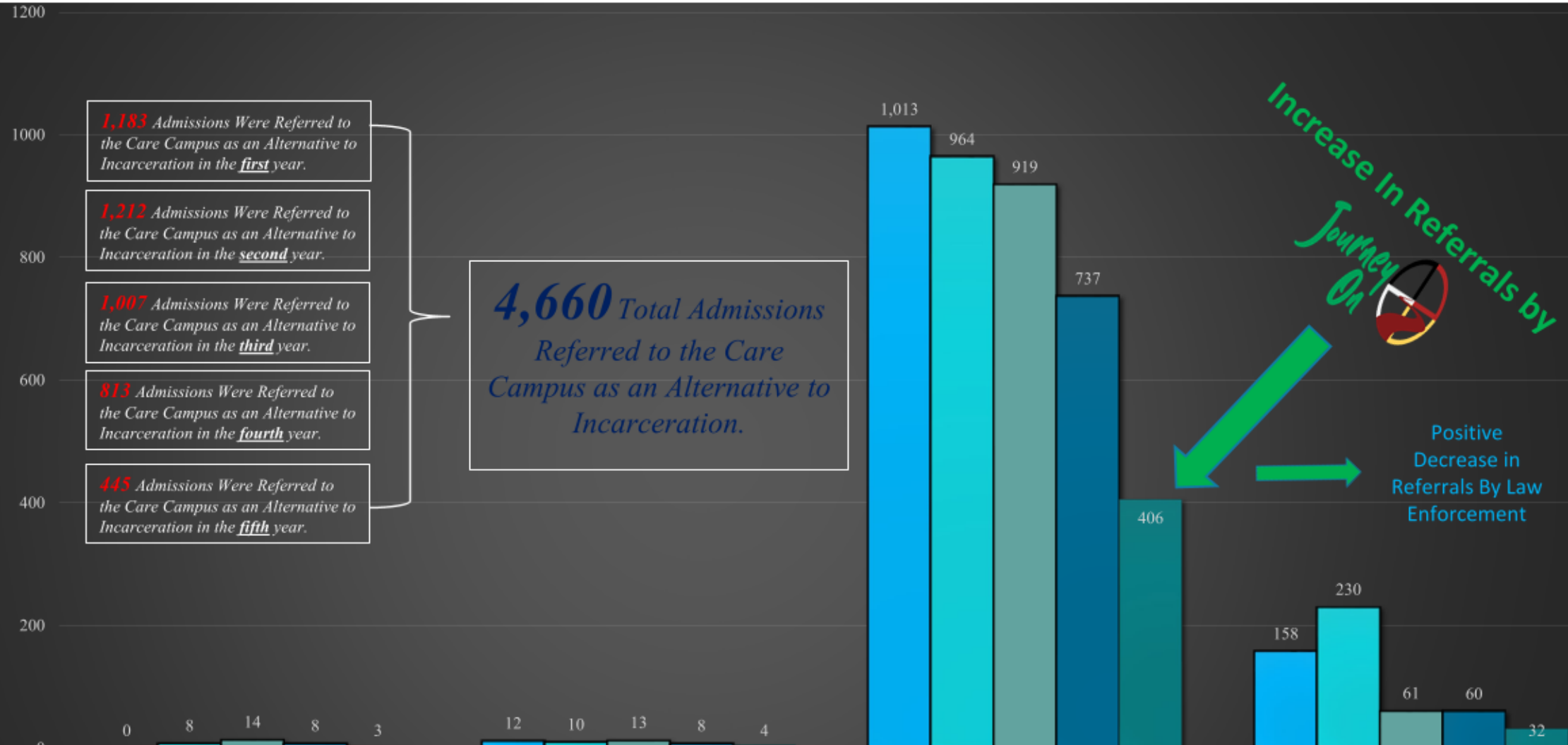
CARE CAMPUS PROGRAM UTILIZATION BY LAW ENFORCEMENT

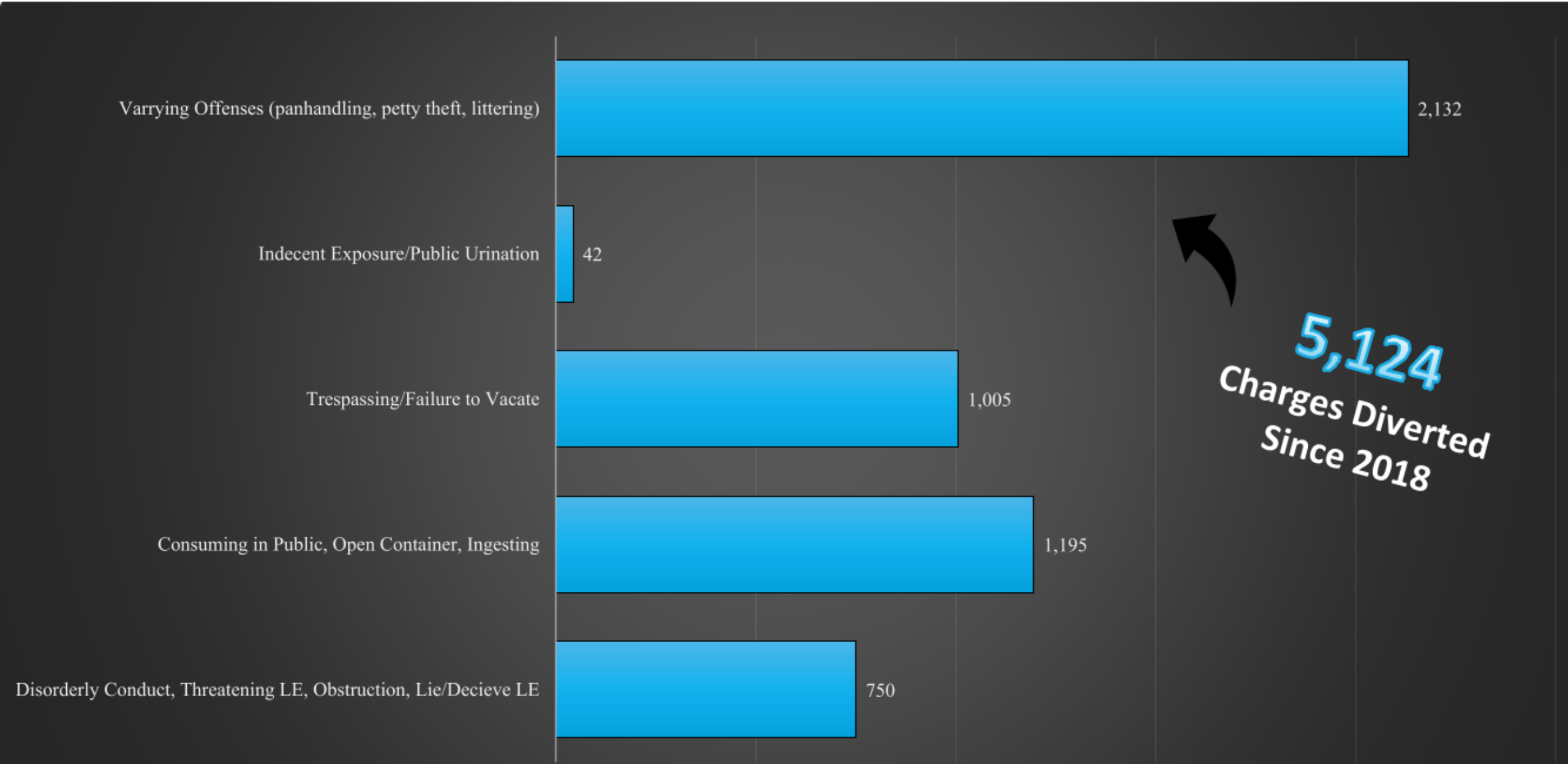

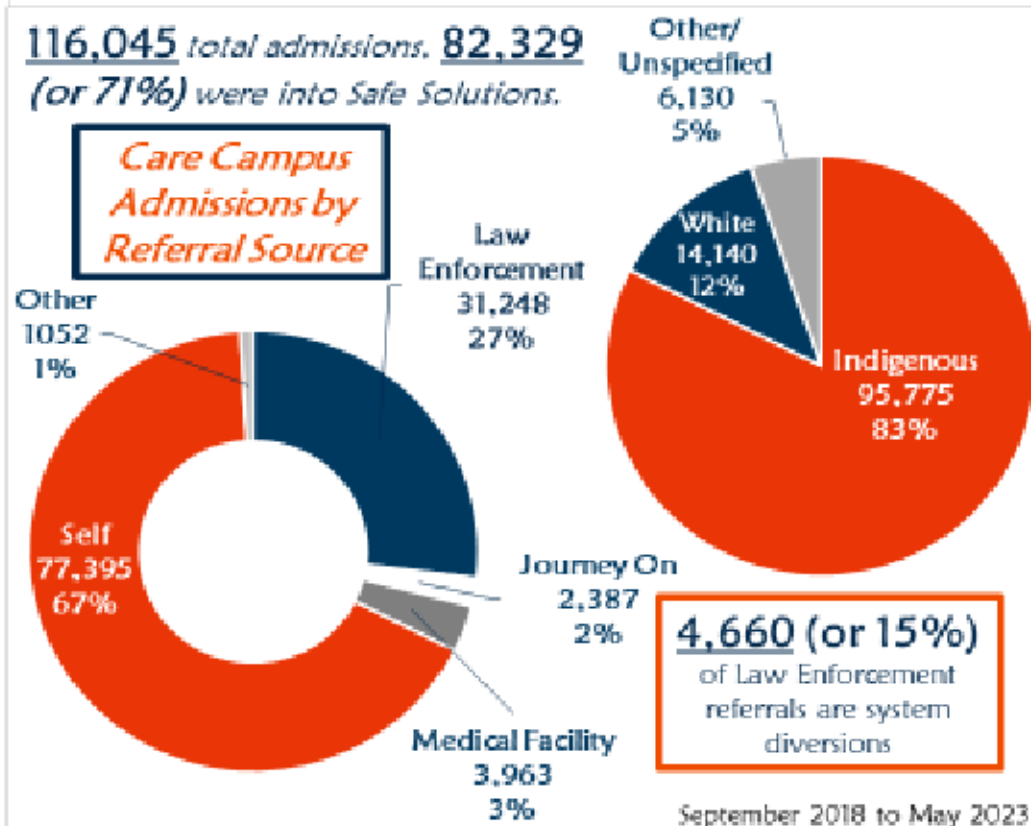

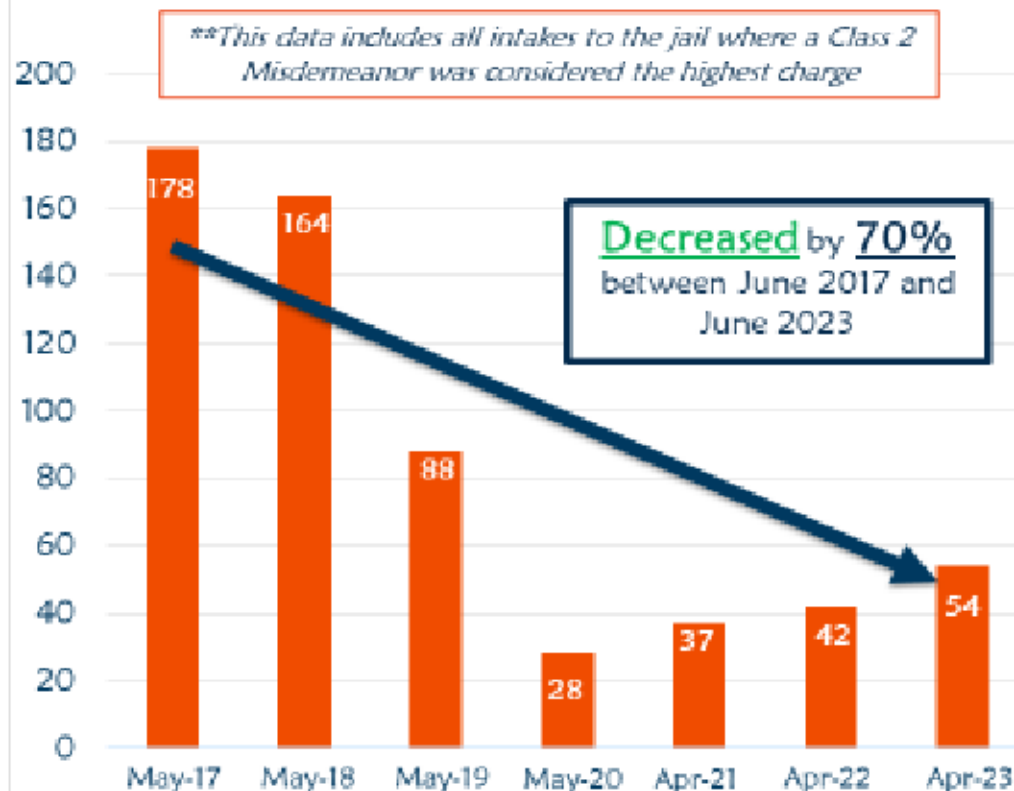

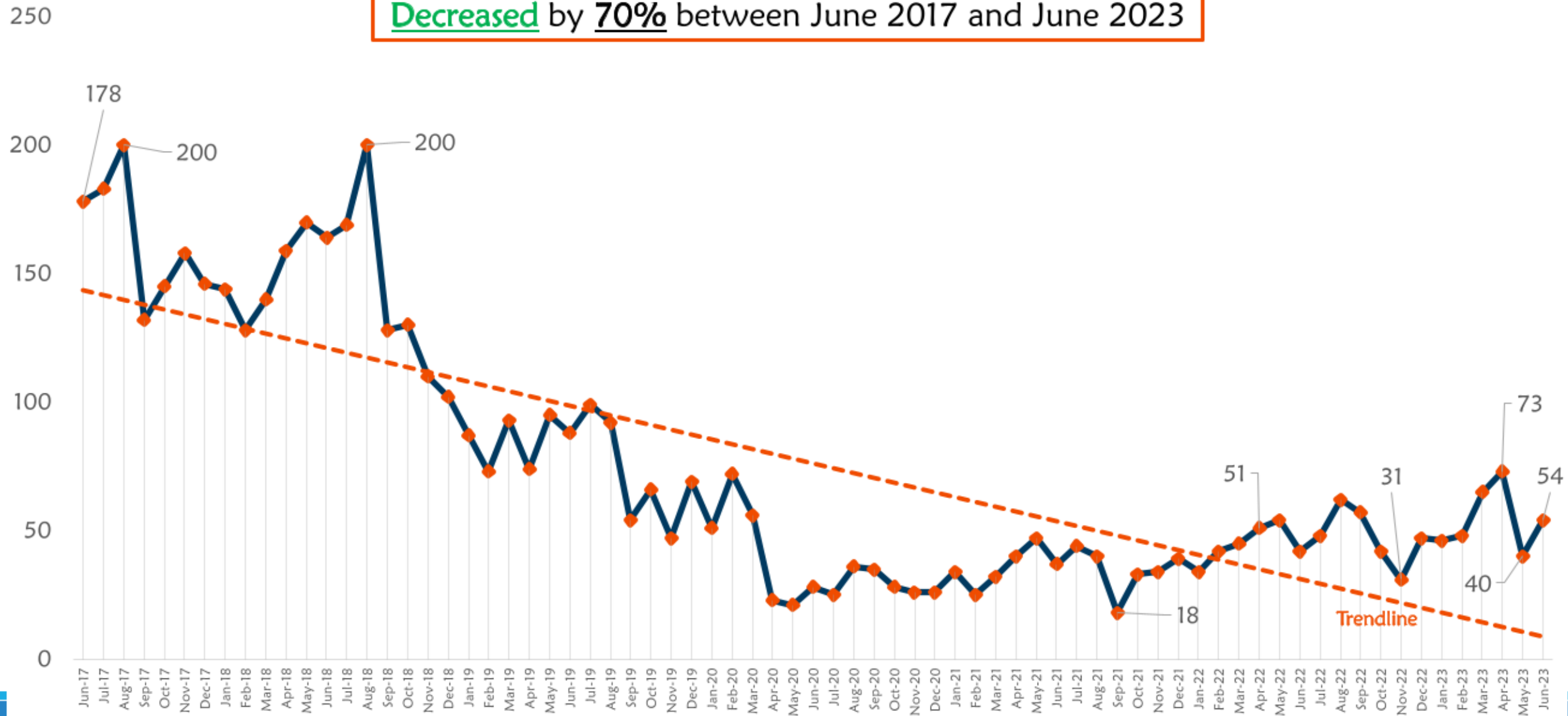


Class 2 Misdemeanors in the Jail

September 26, 2018 to May 31, 2023



Rapid City Police Department:
\$150 per detainment



Pennington County Jail:
\$85 per day



Pennington County States Attorney's Office
\$25 per misdemeanor file prosecuted



Pennington County Public Defender's Office
\$450 per misdemeanor file defended



Pennington County Court House:
\$86.50 expenses factored for misdemeanor files at present time



\$796.50 per individual jail diversion x 4,660 admissions diverted to Care Campus Programs = **\$3,711,690**

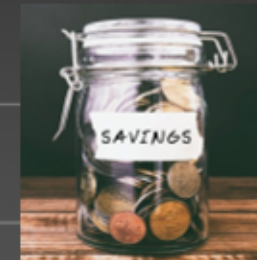
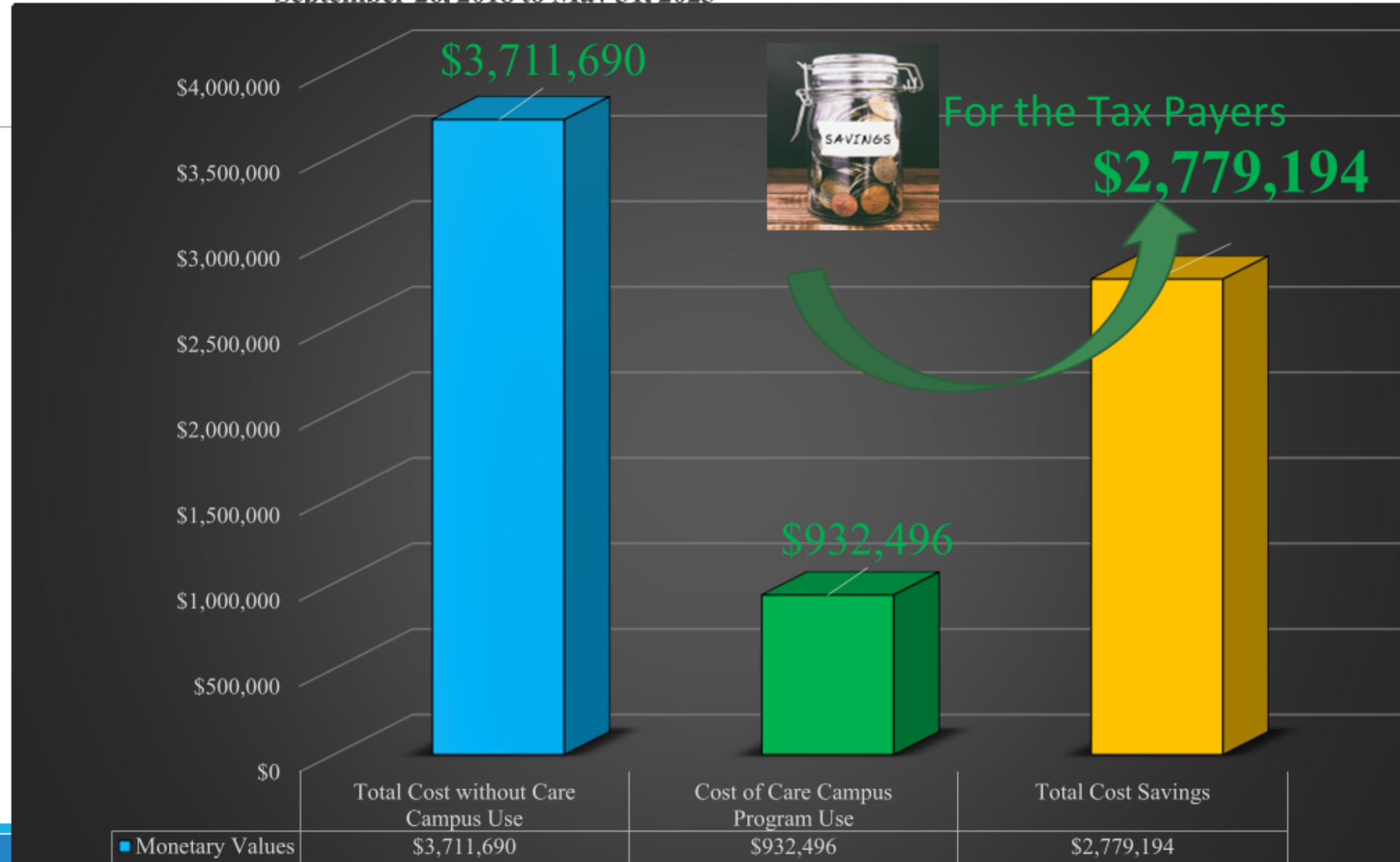
*53 individuals were not assigned a program type and are not reflected in this chart.

*32 individuals were referred to Residential treatment and are not reflected in this chart.

Detoxification costs (\$226 per day/24-hour period) x 4,039 admissions = **\$912,814**

Safe Solutions costs (\$25 per day/24-hour period) x 541 admissions = **\$13,525**

Crisis Care Center costs (\$131 per day/24-hour period) x 47 admissions = **\$6,157**

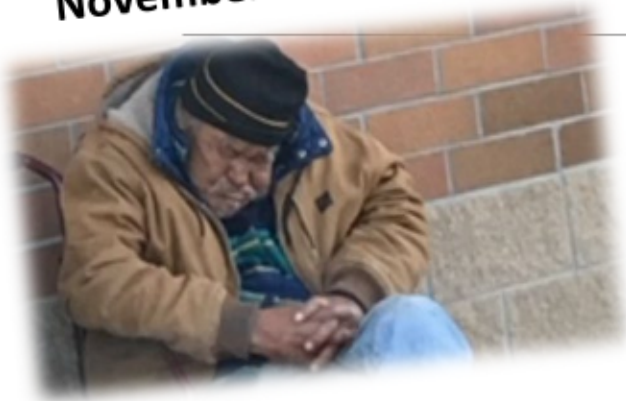
