OUT-OF-STATE PRISON BEDS

- 2023 Legislature approved the addition of 120 temporary, out-of-state prison beds to assist with adult male population management
- \$7.8 million/biennium
- DOC moved 120 inmates to CoreCivic's Saguaro Correctional Center in Eloy, Ariz. at the end of 2023



HOW WERE INMATES SELECTED FOR TRANSFER?

- Custody level (no high security)
- Proximity to parole eligibility (more than two years)
- Participation in treatment, other programming
- Health and mental health needs





PROGRAMMING OPPORTUNITIES

- 70 of 120 inmates (58%) are participating in work assignments, education, or programming
- Work assignments include laundry, landscaping, kitchen, and more
- Education includes GED, carpentry, plumbing, barber training



 Programming includes Inside Out Dad (parenting), Victim Impact, Go Further (life and re-entry coaching)



THE RUFF LIFE - DOG PROGRAM

- In cooperation with the Valley Humane Society, Eloy, Arizona
- 10 Montana inmates participating
- Involves socializing, training, grooming dogs from no-kill shelter



 Dogs stay in cells with inmates – 8 weeks per dog



HOW DID THE TRANSFER AFFECT JAIL **POPULATIONS?**


- 212 inmates transported from county jails to MSP (11/15/23 2/8/24)
- 62 of those were transported from the Yellowstone County Detention Center



- 98 inmates were awaiting transport from county jails to prison on 2/15/24
 - 53 were males and 45 were females

HOW IS THE DOC WORKING TO ADDRESS JAIL POPULATIONS?

- Working with members of the HB 5 Select Committee to seek the most appropriate methods of managing its incarcerated population, including jail holds.
- Implementing a full-time placement team dedicated to ensuring the efficient movement of DOC offenders from jails to treatment and prerelease programs.



• Implementing portions of HB 426 which allow the transfer of inmates who are within 14 months of parole eligibility to prerelease or treatment centers for the purposes of preparing them for release into the community - administrative rules will soon be available for public comment
