- Mississippi passed law last year
- Trend lines on state embrace of AVs is encouraging





## AV law case study: South Dakota

Authorizes L4/5 vehicles w/o a driver on states roads

Complies with all applicable FMVSSs or an any exemption

AV must be able to achieve "minimal risk condition"

Satisfies proof of financial responsibility

Compliance w/ all applicable traffic and motor vehicle safety laws and regulations

Transportation Commission to issue rules
