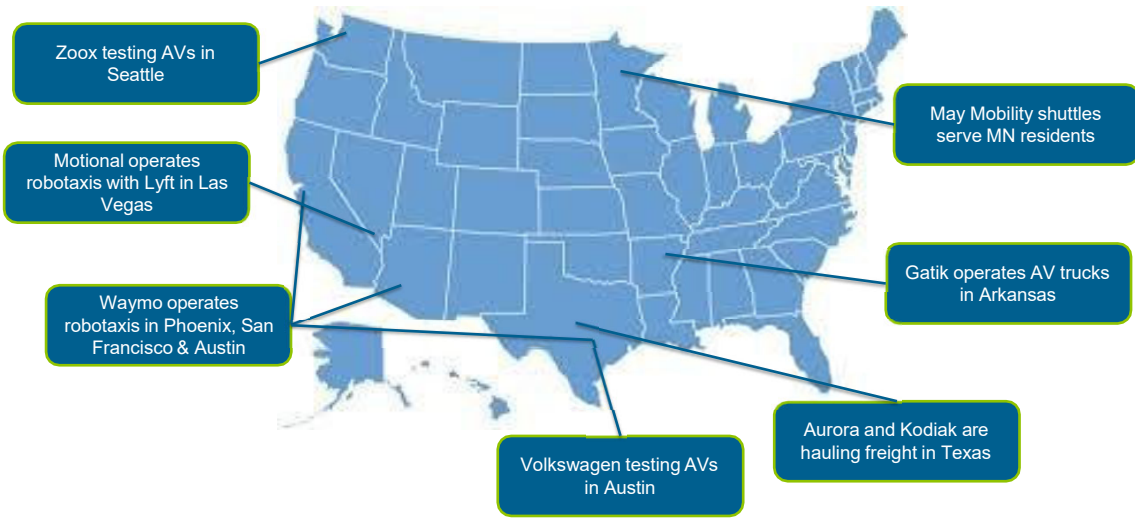

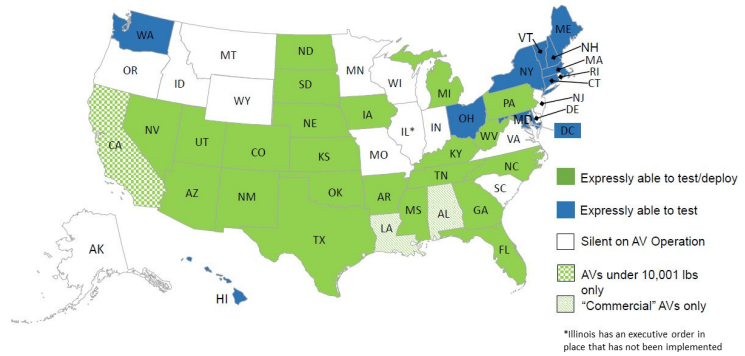
AVs on the Roads



25 states have AV deployment statutes

- This year, South Dakota became the 24th state with an AV statute and Kentucky became the 25th
- Mississippi passed law last year
- Trend lines on state embrace of AVs is encouraging

U.S. State AV Laws & Regulations



AV law case study: South Dakota

Authorizes L4/5 vehicles w/o a driver on states roads	AV must be able to achieve "minimal risk condition"	Compliance w/ all applicable traffic and motor vehicle safety laws and regulations
Complies with all applicable FMVSSs or an any exemption	Satisfies proof of financial responsibility	Transportation Commission to issue rules
