

Administrative Rule Review – September 2023

This memo summarizes administrative rule proposals made by the Department of Transportation (MDT) and the Motor Vehicle Division (MVD).

Reviewing this memo fulfills the Transportation Interim Committee's (TIC) administrative rule review duties. No further action is required.

TIC members may wish to:

- ask TIC staff procedural questions regarding MAPA and these proposals; and
- ask agency representatives substantive questions regarding the rule proposals.

By a majority vote TIC can take many MAPA actions, including:

- requiring a MAPA hearing to be held if one has not been scheduled;
- objecting, delaying adoption of a rule until the 6-month expiration date; and
- objecting agency rulemaking records.
