Anna, by far the most important immediate concern is sorting out the issues we had with the 40H final decree. Those concerns can be divided into two groups: pre-decree issues and post decree issues.

The pre-decree issues included problems with multiple versions of abstracts and the struggle to get a final version we thought was accurate. Refining our approach to an accurate ownership list is also an important pre-decree issue.

Most important, however, are the post-decree concerns. It is absolutely essential for final decree abstracts to reflect water rights that are identical to the court's most recent orders regarding those rights. (ownership updates excepted) The motion to amend from IX Ranch shows this goal was not met, and raises the possibility that other water rights in the final decree are also inaccurate. The extent of the latter problem is unknown.

Accurate final decrees are essential to a meaningful adjudication process. This issue is so important that the water court will not issue any more final decrees until these problems are addressed. It is crucial that the Department identify the scope/extent of the problems with 40H final decree abstracts, the cause of those problems, and solutions which assure those problems will not be repeated in the future.

As you know, the Department has a constitutional and statutory obligation to maintain accurate water right records. The final decree in 40H did not accurately reflect prior orders of the water court and did not give water users an accurate description of their property interests.

Hope this prioritization of concerns helps.

At our December 2021 meeting with DNRC personnel in Helena, we made it clear that the Department does not have authority to modify water rights that have been the subject of prior water court orders, except through the statutory change process or because of updates to ownership. We have re-iterated that principle in several subsequent meetings and received repeated assurances that modification of water rights that have been the subject of prior Water Court orders would stop. The purpose of these communications was to ensure the integrity of court orders and to facilitate issuance of accurate final decrees.

Despite these conversations, it appears Mr. Coey has again modified a water right on his own initiative and without the authorization of this Court. In this instance, Mr. Coey's action effectively negated a Court order issued the previous

As we have indicated many times, this conduct on the part of DNRC personnel is not acceptable. Unfortunately, our efforts to communicate informally about resolution of this problem have been unsuccessful. That means the Court will change its response to these issues in the future if problems with unauthorized modification of water rights by agency

In the meantime, please send me a list of all water rights Mr. Coey has modified without authorization or request of the water court since December 21, 2021. That list should not include water rights modified pursuant to the DNRC's statutory change authority or pursuant to ownership updates. Please tender provide this list by close of business Friday,
