COVID-19 Precautions

Your Comment:

To the Members of the House and Senate Joint Rules Committee, As a nurse and a nurse scientist, I urge you to follow, during the 2021 legislative session, the precautions set forth by the CDC. These include: (a) wearing a mask in public settings and when around people who do not live in the same household, (b) maintaining at least 6 feet of distance between self and others not living in the same household, (c) washing or sanitizing hands frequently, (d) cleaning and disinfecting areas that are touched frequently, and (e) monitoring your health on a daily basis. Please see the following website for more information about these science-based, recommended precautions: <https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/prevent-getting-sick/prevention.html> (updated, 11-27-2020; accessed 12-11-2020) These precautions are not an infringement on the personal autonomy rights of Montana's citizens. They are a matter of public health and safety, just as are regulations about wearing seatbelts, not drinking and driving, not allowing minors to drink, setting speed limits on our roads, maintaining a sewage system to manage dangerous micro-organisms and other substances carried in wastewater, regulating septic tanks, requiring a license to drive, and requiring inspection of food such as meat, dairy, and poultry, to name a few. Just as we adhere to these laws, adhering to COVID-19 precautions demonstrates common sense, backed by science, and respect for the health and safety of Montana's citizens, especially for those who are older and/or those who have other health vulnerabilities.
