**CHAPTER 1**

**COVID-19 Response**

**1-50. Participation during session -- permission by caucus leader to participate remotely.** (1) A member's caucus leader may allow the member to participate remotely and to vote by proxy.

(2) For the purposes of this rule, the caucus leader:

(a) for the majority party in the House is the Speaker of the House, the Speaker pro tempore of the House, or the House Majority Leader;

(b) for the minority party in the House is the House Minority Leader or a representative designated by the House Minority Leader;

(c) for the majority party in the Senate is the Senate President, the President pro tempore of the Senate, or the Senate Majority Leader; and

(d) for the minority party in the Senate is the Senate Minority Leader or a Senator designated by the Senate Minority Leader."

Explanation - This amendment adds a designated member of the House or Senate Minority Leaders to allow remote participation.
