These documents are submitted to the 68th Montana Legislature by the Montana Districting and Apportionment Commission. The submission fulfills the requirements in Article V, section 14, of the Montana Constitution and section 5-1-109, MCA, that the commission submit to the Legislature by the 10th legislative day the commission's plan for legislative redistricting based on the 2020 Census. The plan includes 100 state House districts and 50 state Senate districts, and it assigns 25 holdover senators to districts for the 2025 Legislature. The submission includes a report of the activities of the commission, a state map and regional maps, a table of House districts that are paired to form Senate districts, and other supporting information. The commission's website, mtredistricting.gov, has user-friendly interactive maps and the complete record of the commission's work to date.
