Additional U.S. Census Bureau Statement on "Official" Redistricting Data

August 9, 2021

Question: Which is the Census Bureau's official redistricting data, the August delivery or the September delivery?

Answer: The data included in the August and September deliveries will be identical. States can use either the August delivery or the September delivery as appropriate, taking their own statutes and constitutional requirements into account. The Census Bureau considers both releases to be official and fit for use.
