Flu shots and State-sponsored health screenings are available at no charge for members (or soon to be members) of the State of Montana Benefit Plan (State Plan), but APPOINTMENTS ARE REQUIRED.

Available with an appointment at any Montana Health Center in Butte, Billings, Missoula, Helena, or Anaconda.

Please make your appointment(s) one of the following ways:

- With the CareHere representative on November 14 in the House lobby from 11:00am-3:00pm. **Legislators who are new to the State Plan and want to make an appointment prior to January 2 MUST use this option.**
