What is the General Fund?

- The main “checking account” of state government
- It is not set aside for a specific purpose and is available for all government purposes
- The Legislature prioritizes both revenues and expenditures

Where does the money come from?

- General Fund revenues come from taxes and may be used for any lawful purpose
