

General Fund Growth 2001-2021

The Revenue and Transportation Interim Committee adopted a revenue estimate to present to the legislature for the upcoming 2019 legislative session during its Nov. 19, 2018, meeting. The modest growth is based on the economic outlook provided by IHS Markit and also reflects the fact that nearly 25% of Montana’s general fund revenue sources are expected to be essentially flat or decline from FY 2018 levels throughout the forecast period. The red line illustrates the average growth of 4.1% from FY 2000 to FY 2018.
