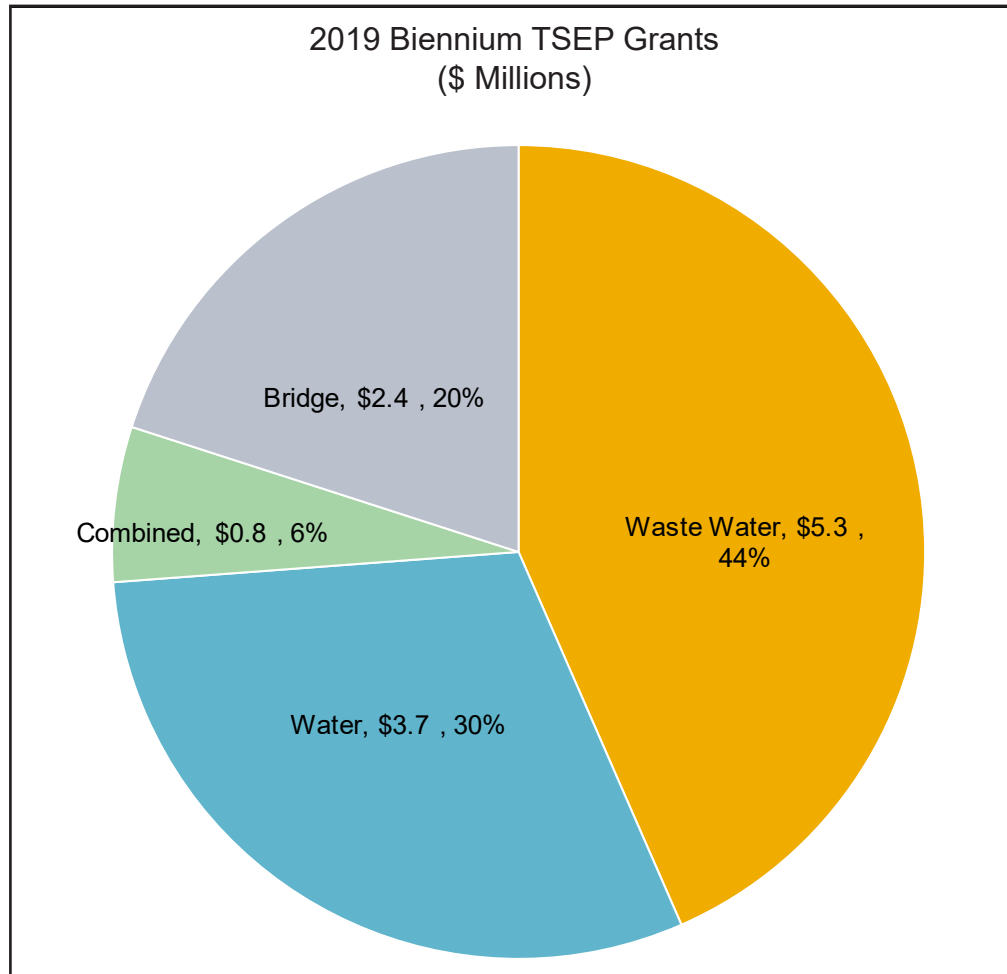


Local Government Water & Wastewater Infrastructure Funding



The Treasure Statement Endowment Program (TSEP) is a state-funded program designed to help address the affordability of local infrastructure projects by providing grants to lower the cost of constructing public facilities. The program was authorized by Montana voters through Legislative Referendum 110 on June 2, 1992.

As this chart shows, the breakdown of the total project funding for the TSEP projects in the 2019 biennium was \$12.1 million, after the funding reductions during the 2017 special session. Wastewater and drinking water infrastructure projects received 80% of the project funding.
