


County Jail Holds Paid by the Department of Corrections



The 2017 Legislature directed the Department of Corrections (DOC) to pay no more than \$69 per day to house inmates in county jails. The DOC contracts with 37 counties for jail holds and reimburses their costs for housing offenders that have been sentenced to DOC and are waiting on transport to prison or other facility placement. The legislature provided \$1 million per year to the DOC contingent upon them achieving several benchmarks including that county jail holds be below 250 as of January 1, 2018, which they have accomplished, and maintained below that number for the rest of FY 2018 and FY 2019.
